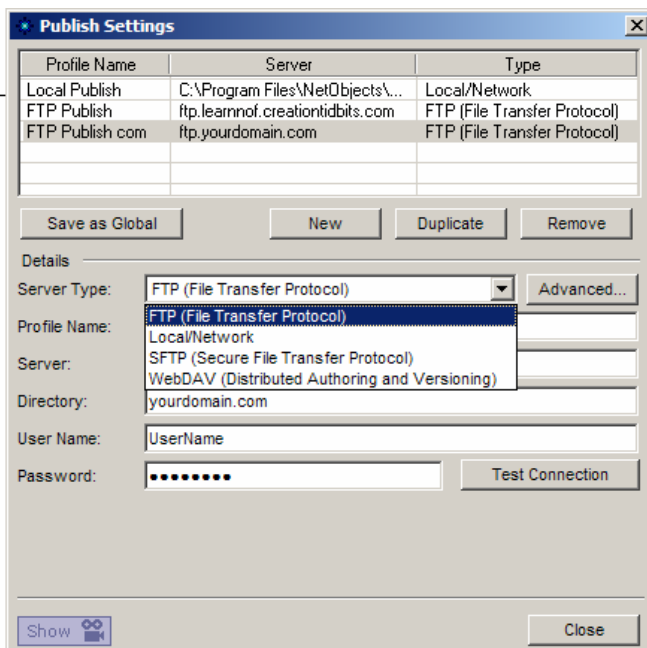
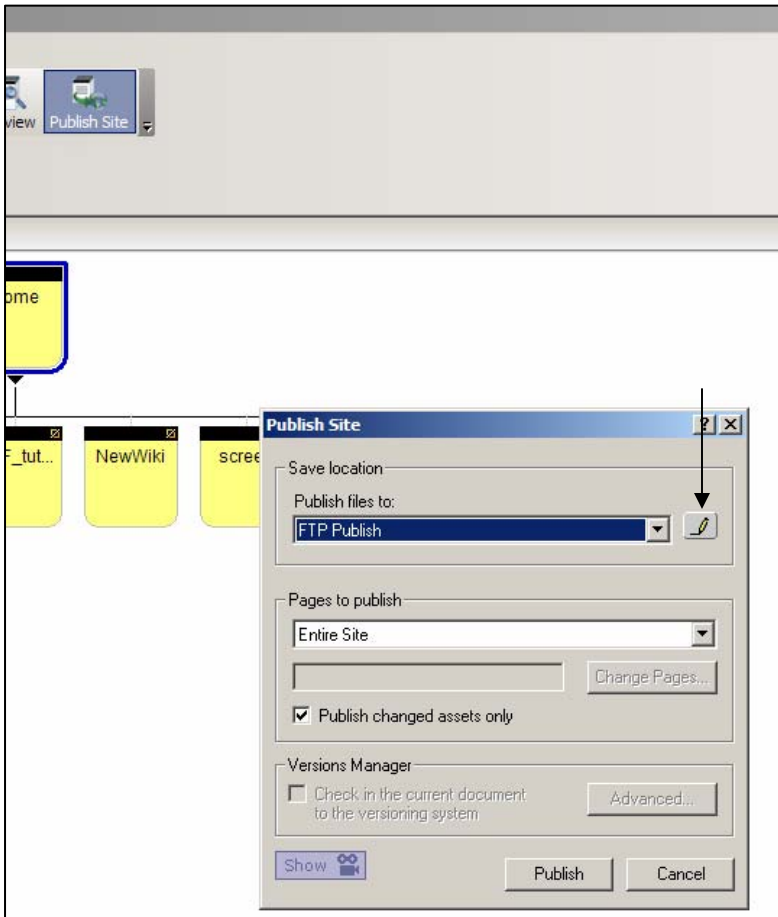


NOF Publish Settings

This tutorial will explain how to set up your publish settings for your webhost. Click the 'Publish Site' icon at the top of the page. Then when the wizard pops up, click the little pen button on the right. (where the arrow is)

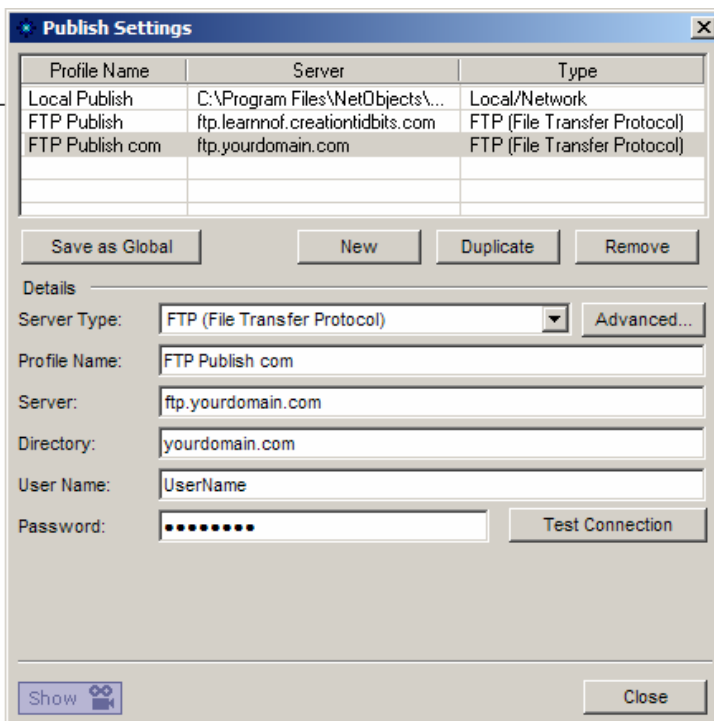


Click the 'Server Type' dropdown box. Select what you need, almost always it will be the 'FTP (File Transfer Protocol)' option.

The you need to fill out the fields.

1. 'Profile Name': Give it a name you will remember, like 'FTP Publish (my site.com)'
2. 'Server': That will be 'ftp.yourdomain.com'
3. 'Directory': this will be 'yourdomain.com (or /public_html , just whatever they tell you is your Directory)
4. 'User Name': You site's user name
5. 'Password': Your sites password.

Then click the 'Test Connection' button. If you get an error message, check to make sure you have the proper password and username and ftp address. When everything is good you will get a message that says 'Connected!'. Click 'Close'.



Now it will bring you to the publish settings again. Make sure that your new FTP setting it selected in the dropdown box, and click the 'Publish' button. If it goes through without any errors you are done! But if you get an error that says "This directory does not exist, Should NOF create it?". Hit No, because that means you did not get your directory setting right. Check with your host for the proper setting.
